

CENTURIA VILLAGE BOARD MINUTES  
March 25, 2020

A Special Meeting of The Village Board was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by President Stan Swiontek with Katie Peterson absent. Director of Public Works, Tony Weinzirl, and Village Clerk Karen Edgell were also present.

On March 24, 2020, Wisconsin Governor Tony Evers directed the Department of Health Services to issue a Safer at Home Order (see attached). In light of the Covid-19 Pandemic and by order of the Governor, Village President Stan Swiontek prepared the following declaration:

*Following the directives from Governor Evers, beginning Wednesday, March 25, 2020 it is critical that all non-essential employees stay home. Non-essential employees, who are unable to work as determined by their supervisor, will be eligible to use up to 80 hours of paid administrative leave, pending Board approval. Non-essential employees, using emergency leave under this provision, must be available to work as directed by their supervisor and may be directed to support activities for the COVID-19 response efforts. All Committee and Department meetings are cancelled until further notice. The regularly scheduled Board Meeting on April 13 is cancelled.*

The Board unanimously approved Stan's declaration and will use Supervisor's discretion for implementation.

The motion was made by Kevin Kamish, seconded by Tom Boettcher, to adjourn. Motion carried.
